



CASA Accredited Private & Commercial Pilot Medicals

We conduct Private and Commercial Pilot Medicals from our Blackbutt rooms

Class 1

This medical standard applies to holders of an Air Transport Pilot Licence, Commercial Pilot Licence (other than balloons), Multi-crew Pilot (aeroplane) Licence, Flight Engineer Licence or Student Flight Engineer Licence.

Unless otherwise advised, a Class 1 medical certificate is valid for one year.

Class 2

This medical applies to holders of a Student Pilot Licence, Private Pilot Licence, Commercial Pilot (Balloon) Licence and Flight Radio Operator Licence.

Unless otherwise advised, a Class 2 medical certificate is valid for four years for applicants less than 40 years of age on the day of issue or two years for those aged over 40 years.

Class 3

This medical standard applies to holders of an Air Traffic Control Licence or and Flight Service Officer.

Unless otherwise advised, a Class 3 medical certificate is valid for two years.

Recreational Aviation Medical

Allows appropriately licenced pilots to exercise the privileges of the recreational pilot Licence without the requirement to hold a CASA Class 2 medical.

Unless otherwise advised, a Recreational Aviation Medical is valid 2 years until the age of 65 when validity becomes yearly.

CASA requires test for Class 1 & 3 medicals that are determined by age and may include an ECG, Blood tests & Ophthalmology assessment.

Pre Appointment Checklist:

- Bring Photo ID to all appointments
 - Complete your online Aviation medical BEFORE appointment
 - Bring most recent aviation medical certificate to your appointment
 - Bring along any recent test results you may have had
 - Bring along any corrective glasses or contact lenses

On The Day

New patients to Blackbutt-

- Advise the receptionist you have not attended Blackbutt Doctors prior to this consult
- You will be booked in 10mins with the nurse and 30mins with Dr Mark Whitty
- If you require blood test or an ophthalmology assessment please advise the receptionist and they can organise the paperwork prior to consult. This means all tests can be done before attending Initial consult
- If you require an ECG let the reception team know and the nurse can perform this on the day at the surgery.
- All online Aviation Medical self-assessment information has to be filled out before consult.

Existing patient-

- Advise the receptionist you would like to book in to have you Aviation Assessment
- You will be booked in for 30mins with Dr Mark Whitty
- If you require blood test or an ophthalmology assessment please advise the receptionist and they can organise the paperwork prior to consult. This means all tests can be done before attending Initial consult
- If you require an ECG let the reception team know and the nurse can perform this on the day at the surgery.
- All online Aviation Medical self-assessment information has to be filled out before initial consult.
